Poverty and Health

It can be very difficult for people living in poverty to meet their nutritional needs. Being in the lowest income group can increase a person's risk of getting chronic diseases such as diabetes, heart disease and certain types of cancers.

Food Insecurity = not having enough food or worrying that there is not enough to eat.

13.5% households in the Haliburton, Kawartha, Pine Ridge District are food insecure. This is higher than the Ontario rate of 11%.

&

50% or more of people of all ages are not getting enough veggies and fruit.

The Reality for Low Income Earners:

- 59% struggle to put food on the table
- Many skip meals to pay their bills and end up hungry
- Often are forced to choose less healthy foods

A family of 4 in Haliburton County needs **\$6,358** a month to live with dignity and meet their basic needs.

Environment

Did you know?

40% of all food produced in Canada is wasted and contributes to greenhouse gas emissions such as methane when it breaks down. This amounts to \$31 billion dollars' worth of food each year.


